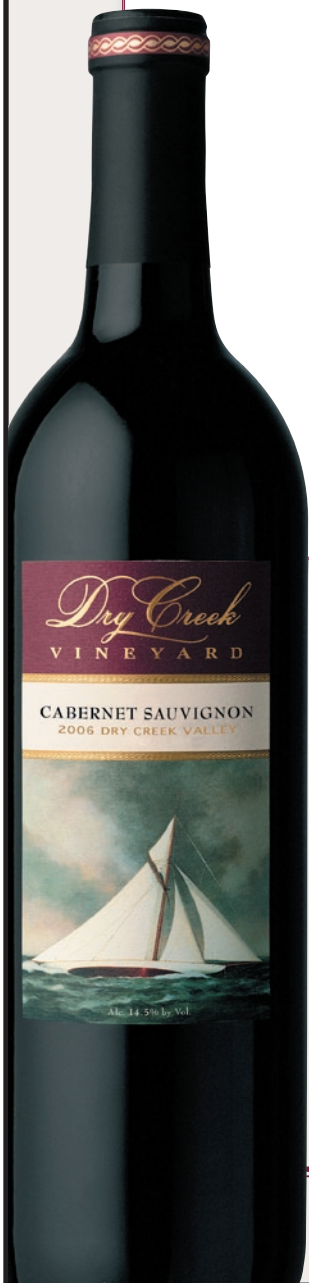

GRAPES: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot, and 1% Cabernet Franc

APPELLATION: Dry Creek Valley

HARVEST: September 27 – October 30, 2006

FERMENTATION: Fermented 18 days at an average temperature of 83°F

BARREL AGING: 20 months in 54% French oak, 28% American oak and 18% Hungarian oak, 40% new oak

ALCOHOL: 14.5%

TOTAL ACIDITY: 0.57

pH: 3.74

RESIDUAL SUGAR: Dry
