Each year, The Red Cat restaurant in New York City prepares a traditional Thanksgiving meal. And Raoul Segarra, wine director, meets the challenge of pairing wines to the eclectic flavors of the holiday table. His rule: Match to the meal's centerpiece, and everything else will follow. "You need a fresh, juicy wine to pair with white-meat turkey, which can be dry," he says.
