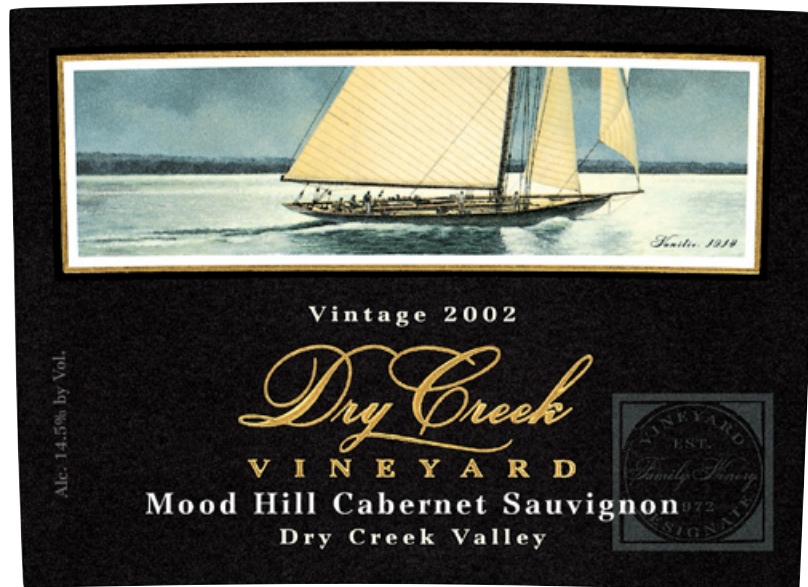


2002 MOOD HILL CABERNET SAUVIGNON – DRY CREEK VALLEY

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

Well-balanced, structured and dense, the 2002 Mood Hill Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits an opulent nose of rich black cherry and wild berry that offer floral aromas. Flavors of black plum and black cherry are the hallmark of this vineyard, located on the western edge of Dry Creek Valley. Layers of fruit and dry-spice co-mingle on the palate with hints of vanilla bean, as rich, round tannins promote lingering layers of smoky espresso throughout the long and detailed finish.



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
