“The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon Hillside and Benchland Vineyards (aged 19 months in French oak) is a beauty. **This serious Cabernet Sauvignon showcases just how good Cabernet can be from Dry Creek**, although most readers would agree it is better known for Zinfandel.

Dense ruby/purple, loads of black cherry, black currant and dusty/loamy soil notes are present in this medium to full-bodied, concentrated and powerful wine. This is a blockbuster, full-bodied, impressively endowed Cabernet Sauvignon to drink over the next 20 - 25 years.”
