Michael Surles and our then graphic designer, Steve Quirt, would sit around in our Petaluma home brainstorming different sailboat concepts. We would pour through books from the Rosenfeld Collection - the largest archive of maritime photographs in the United States. We talked at length about how the sailboat needed to match the "mood" of the wine. For example, the slim lines of certain boats that were more feminine matched better with our white wines. Sturdier looking boats that appeared masculine seemed to do a better job expressing our red wines. We thought we were pretty cool then!

Today, sailboats continue to grace our labels and while the glass, paper and even the closures have changed, one thing remains consistent – our passion for sailing and our respect for America's nautical heritage. I am personally proud to say that Dry Creek Vineyard's sailboat imagery is trademarked and will remain the centerpiece of our brand. Our winery is the "Official Wine for Sailors" and that piece of authenticity can never be taken away.

## AN ARTISTIC EXPRESSION

Ur roots in the sailing community run deep. Since 1982, sailboat imagery has graced our labels, capturing the spirit of the high seas and our passion for the sport. The irony of a winery named Dry Creek Vineyard with sailboats on the labels is not lost on us – it is certainly a family quirk and yet it makes perfect sense. We believe that the art of winemaking and the skill of sailing have a lot in common. Like winemaking, sailing is fun, adventuresome and romantic. Like sailing, the art of winemaking demands skill, discipline and plenty of help from Mother Nature.

The story of the sailboats on our labels carries almost as much history as the winery itself. Dating back to the first sailboat on the 1982 David S. Stare Reserve Red, we made an intentional effort to choose a class of boat that would fit the nature of the winery. We decided early on that the J Class yachts would be our inspiration – specifically those boats from 1929 to 1937. Considered the golden years of yachting, the J's of the 30s were in a class by themselves. They were extremely dangerous to sail and the complex rigging and lack of a motor made them sailable only for the most experienced skippers.

From the very beginning, we have worked with local artist Michael Surles to create these original pieces of art that have come to express each of our wines. Michael has been the only artist we have ever worked with. His innate ability to capture the spirit of these boats is uncanny from their shape and color, all the way down to the intricate rigging on the sails. We thought it would be interesting to provide a rundown of each of the classic boats that grace our labels:

For our Chenin Blanc, we selected Rainbow. She was designed and built to defend the America's Cup against Endeavour in 1934. After losing the first two races, she went on to win the next four races and defend the cup. We love Rainbow because the boat speaks to the freshness of our Dry Chenin Blanc. It's a summery wine and Rainbow epitomizes those fresh fruit flavors.

Lulworth is the boat that graces our Fumé Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc bottles. Built in 1920, Lulworth's name comes from Lulworth Castle, which belonged to her second owner. Lulworth was built as a racing boat to compete in the premier yachting league in Europe: the British "Big Class." Lulworth embodies the essence of our flagship wine. The boat is modern and sleek yet displays old world charm – much like our Fumé and Sauvignon Blanc wines.

Dark, brooding and intense. These words all describe our Heritage Vines Zinfandel. The classic yacht Lutine captures the heart of this Zinfandel. Lutine is the name given to all Lloyd's of London yachts and is modeled after the J boat, Ranger. Interestingly, Ranger was the last J Class yacht to sail in the America's Cup, successfully defending in 1937 in Newport, RI.

## LEE AND EUGENIA STEFFENS

Lee Steffens certainly racks up the air miles. As a Project Executive for a commercial builder, Lee finds himself on an airplane almost every week. And while the travel can definitely be a grind, one benefit of all of those miles is the free tickets for vacations. That's where our story begins – 14 years ago on a weekend trip to wine country. Having arrived in California, Lee and Eugenia stayed in Oakland. On their first morning, they asked the concierge which wineries they should visit in the area. The first stop they made was at Dry Creek Vineyard. They fell in love with our wines and have been club members ever since.

Over the years, the Steffens have attended numerous Dry Creek Vineyard events. Each December, they treat themselves (Lee calls it a special Christmas gift they give to each other) by coming to the winery for our Holiday Winemaker dinner. In 2010, they attended a wine club cruise to Italy and bonded with several couples who have become dear friends. They even signed up their best friends from Minnesota who have also become a part of the Dry Creek Vineyard family. Years later, their friends' son served Dry Creek Vineyard wines at their wedding. It is certainly a family affair. Having been members of the winery all these years, Lee and Eugenia both love the friendly nature of the staff and of course, all of the wines. What's their favorite wine? "The one in the glass," quips Lee.

Our thanks go out to the Steffens for their support and friendship!

Many of you are familiar with our single vineyard Zinfandels such as Beeson Ranch and Somers Ranch. Reliance is the name of the J boat that expresses these unique wines. We chose Reliance for a few reasons. First, when she was built, Reliance was the largest gaff rigged cutter ever conceived and was called a "freak" by many in the sailing community. Most folks thought she could not be sailed safely. For us, Reliance embraces this idea of pushing the envelope - crafting wines from difficult vineyards and complex terroir that often times leaves our winemaking team scratching their heads.

Zio and Nightwind are the names of the yachts that characterize our single vineyard white wines - Taylor's Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, DCV3 Sauvignon Blanc and DCV10 Chardonnay. These boats were built in 1939

and this particular image is a famous one. Captured at a key moment, each boat is reaching under spinnaker (meaning the front sail is out, powering the boat downwind) heading down the middle of Long Island Sound during a New York Yacht Club cruise. The spirit in this particular image with its bright hues, struck us as matching perfectly with our most cherished white wines.

Finally, we come to Endeavour. Endeavour

was built in 1934 as a challenger for the America's Cup. Ironically, she lost to Rainbow, the boat on our Dry Chenin Blanc label. At the time, Endeavour was one of the most technologically advanced boats ever conceived. We thought this would be a perfect match for our Endeavour Cabernet Sauvignon, which when planted, was one of the most technologically advanced vineyards ever conceived in the region.

The timelessness of these sailboats carries on in each new vintage of wine we produce. Each boat depicts a specific element in the wine - they complement each other. The artistic expression of these paintings embodies the hard work and artisan approach in our winemaking efforts. For us, sailing and wine is the perfect pairing.
