90 Points - The 2014 DCV7 Estate Zinfandel - Wallace Ranch reveals a medium to deep garnet color and nose of black berries and black raspberries with hints of Chinese five spice, garrigue and tilled earth. The full-bodied palate delivers a lot of fruit, supported by firm, chewy tannins and just enough acid, finishing with great length and balance.
