2013 ENDEAVOUR CABERNET SAUVIGNON – *Dry Creek Valley*

<p>ROBERT PARKER'S WINE ADVOCATE March 2016</p>	<p>93 Points - The 2013 Endeavour Cabernet Sauvignon, a more limited Cuvée of only 995 cases, is meant to be their top Cuvée of Cabernet Sauvignon. It was aged 20 months in French oak prior to bottling. This is a serious, backward, rich, concentrated, firmly structured wine with a top-quality Bordeaux as an inspiration. Rich and deep, the wine has cedary graphite notes intermixed with black currants, cherries and loamy soil notes. This wine is full-bodied and should not be touched for another 4 - 5 years, but it is clearly capable of lasting 25 - 30+ years.</p>
<p>WINE SPECTATOR August 2016</p>	<p>91 Points - Reminiscent of a fine Bordeaux, this is well-structured and built to cellar, with a tight core of dusty blackberry, wild berry, cedary oak, gravel and road tar flavors, supported by chewy, fine-grained tannins. Drink now through 2030. 995 cases made.</p>
<p>WINE ENTHUSIAST December 2016</p>	<p>91 Points - The producer does a fine job in this, one of its highest-end offerings, the wine including 10% Petit Verdot. Juicy and grippy in a generosity of black currant, cherry and gunpowder, it also has a leathery component that provides a sinewy edge.</p>
