2018 DCV ESTATE BLOCK 10 CHARDONNAY – *Russian River Valley*

WINE ENTHUSIAST September 2020	90 Points – The majority of this wine was barrel fermented and aged in French oak. It offers a steely, straightforward frame of Meyer lemon and stone, with an underlying richness on the midpalate of pear and fig dusted lightly in nutmeg.
CALIFORNIA GRAPEVINE May 2020	90 Points – Very Highly Recommended – Medium-light yellow; attractive, fresh, clean, floral, green apple and white peach aroma with hints of honeysuckle and lemon zest; medium to medium-full body; crisp, lemony, apple flavors with bright acidity and a light trace of oak; lingering aftertaste.

CALIFORNIA GRAPEVINE April 2018	90 Points – Very Highly Recommended – Medium-light golden yellow; assertive, fresh, baked apple and ripe peach aroma with tropical notes, and hints of lime zest, honeysuckle, and orange blossoms; medium to medium-full body; nicely balanced, slightly buttery, apple and tropical fruit flavors with good depth, bright acidity, and a slight creaminess in the mouthfeel; lingering aftertaste.
