2017 OLD VINE ZINFANDEL – *Dry Creek Valley*

CONNOISSEUR'S GUIDE
TO CALIFORNIA WINE
March 2020

91 Points – This is just good, old-fashioned, right-down-the pike, ripe, nicely balanced Zinfandel. Its fruit is well-concentrated and accessible yet has a nice bit of vitality that keeps things going across the palate and into a clean and continuous finish.

WINE ENTHUSIAST

90 Points – From vines averaging 100 years in age, this hearty wine brings blackberry jam, vanilla and black cherry to the fore. Thick tannins support a full-bodied palate, highlighted in black pepper and baking spice.

WINE SPECTATOR
June 2020

90 Points – Dense and gutsy, this bruiser offers rustic black cherry, dried sage and smoked pepper flavors that build toward firm tannins. Best after 2020. 1,500 cases made.

91 Points – A brisk, cool and zesty red with gentle rose scents that last, this wine delivers all of its energy when first opened. The texture is generous, carrying its full share of alcohol, the wine ready to serve with grilled lamb.
