92 Points - It is a rich, vibrant wine, with fine texture and a lengthy finish. The predominance of Sauvignon Blanc allows you to enjoy it now, but I believe it will improve within the next five years. It has 13.9 percent alcohol. It might turn out to be Dry Creek Vineyard's finest white wine.
