1972	First winery built in Dry Creek Valley after Prohibition, revitalizing the region's wine industry First to plant Sauvignon Blanc in the Dry Creek Valley Introduced Sonoma County's first Fumé Blanc
1982	Unveils new sailboat labels, inspired by the family's love of sailing
1983	Initiated Dry Creek Valley AVA status and first to label a wine with the Dry Creek Valley appellation
1985	First winery to use the term "Meritage" on a label to describe a Bordeaux-style blend
1987	First to coin the term "Old Vine Zinfandel"
1997	First to release Zinfandel from "Heritage" vines
1998	Pioneers the California Sustainable Winegrowing Program
2007	Transition from 1st to 2nd generation
2014	Received sustainable winery and vineyard certification
2015	Selected as Wine & Spirits Magazine Top 100 Winery
2016	Official Wine of the Louis Vuitton America's Cup World Series Races in New York and Chicago
