

90 Points - Flirting with elements of earth and mushrooms but governed first and last by a deep and sustained mix of blackberries and cassis, this expressive, moderately full-bodied offering counts very good structure and balance among its many achievements, and, while nominally tannic, it avoids the astringent excesses to which Cabernet Franc is often prone. It is still a bit tight on the back end, but its essential fruit is beautifully sustained, and its fine construction makes for easy predictions of continued growth for a half-dozen or more years.
