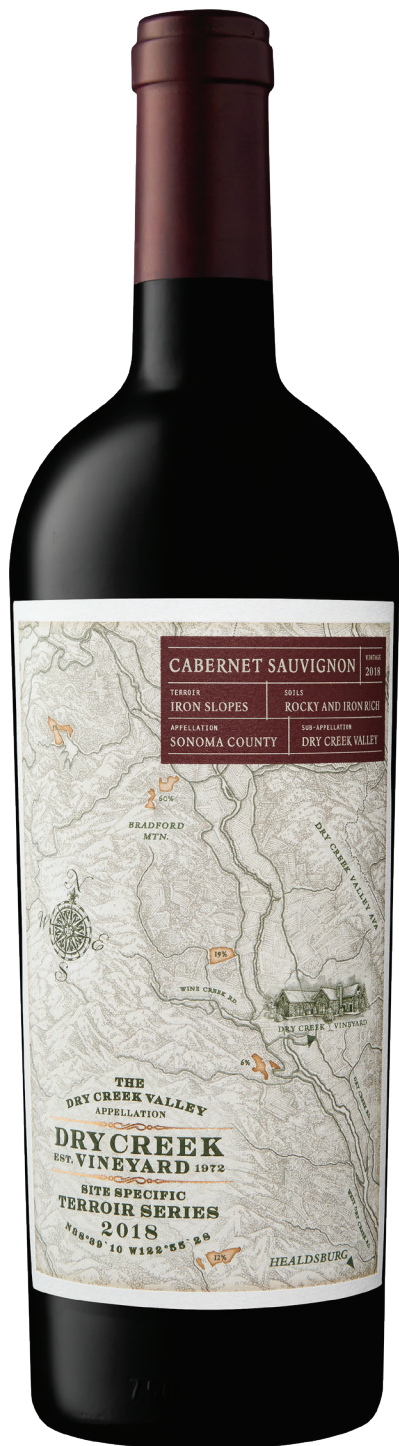




CABERNET SAUVIGNON “IRON SLOPES”

90 Points - From the producer's site-specific *terroir* series—in this case a site replete with rocky iron-rich soils—this is blended with 5% Malbec and richly flavorful in black cherry, plum, cedar and dried herb. Pillowy tannins support a powerful midpalate of structure and texture. -Virginie Boone

2016 VINTAGE

94 Points - Cellar Selection - Blended with 13% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot, this impressively balanced yet sleek red shows a tart currant tone, with a hint of blood orange. Grippy in tannin and oak, accents of dark chocolate and cinnamon round it out. Enjoy 2026-2031. -Virginie Boone
