


## DCV8 ESTATE ZINFANDEL — FARMHOUSE VINEYARD

WINE ENTHUSIAST AUGUST 2020 **94 Points -** From an estate vineyard in the famous appellation, this is the producer's third vintage of this wine. Juicy in black cherry, it has complexity and structure to spare amidst silky-smooth tannins and appealing elements of nutmeg, clove and black pepper. –Virginie Boone

CALIFORNIA GRAPEVINE SEPTEMBER 2020 **91 Points -** Medium to medium-dark ruby; attractive, ripe, slightly jammy, dark cherry, raspberry, and blueberry fruit aroma with hints of dried herbs and baking spice; full body; forward, rich, plush, spicy, red and black fruit flavors with nice acid balance and hints of mocha and black pepper; full tannin; lingering aftertaste.
