2019 VINTAGE
GROWING SEASON

The 2019 growing season was mild, with summer arriving later than usual. This seasonal shift extended hang time, allowing for even ripening, full flavor development, and the retention of natural acidity. Harvest began about a week later than average and stretched nearly 70 days, thanks to consistently favorable conditions. This long window let us pick each vineyard block at optimal ripeness, resulting in balanced, expressive wines with depth, complexity, and nuance — a vintage that truly rewarded patience in the vineyard.

Founded in 1972 by David S. Stare, Dry Creek Vineyard was the first new winery in the Dry Creek Valley following Prohibition. Dave’s vision to start a winery modeled after a Loire Valley chateau reintroduced the world to the wines of northern Sonoma County. Today, his daughter Kim Stare Wallace continues to build on these established traditions while innovating for the future. With the second generation firmly at the helm, the stewardship and future of Dry Creek Vineyard has never been brighter.
